Percentiles, what I'm reporting above, indicate a ranking – where a student, class, school or group stands in relation to others who took the test. The scores above indicate CLS' SCHOOL percentile rank within the National School Norms. The percentile rankings above indicate Christ Lutheran School's relative position in a group (all schools nationally that took this test) in terms of schools scoring *below* us. Therefore, scores in the 50's indicate much the same as a '5' did in the Stanine scores - Average. A score of 80 for example indicates that 79% of the schools taking this test scored below CLS. The scores above are for each test battery at every grade level. Core is a summary of all batteries except those to its right, and Composite summarizes everything. CLS classes generally rank in the upper 1/3 to 1/4 of classes nationally.
